


Bike ride starts in the main square, continues in the main streets of the city center, has a max length of 5 km, and max speed is 10 km/h.

Beginning as a small event in Izmir, the "Fancy Women Bike Ride" (Süslü Kadınlar Bisiklet Turu) has since grown into a parade of over 30,000 women.

Held annually in over 50 cities in Turkey, it increases the visibility of female bicycle users, encouraging them to parade on bike through the streets while wearing fancy clothes. In doing so, the ride proves that biking is parallel without bern surged composition and reflection series.
